
Startup Crawl

"The biggest startup party of the year" was held in downtown Fayetteville on Friday, Sept. 14, where people could meet entrepreneurs from several of Fayetteville's up-and-coming new businesses while drinking some of the areas best craft beers and enjoying live music. The Crawl kicked off at the Arkansas Research & Technology Park, highlighting innovative businesses at the park. The event then continued in the Historic Downtown Square for a self-guided tour with stops featuring more than 40 businesses, dinner at food trucks and beer from several of the area's local breweries, including all 11 partners of the Fayetteville Ale Trail. There were 1503 people registered in attendance.
